2. Local procedures

2.1 Competition classes

AZ CUP 2025 will be held in the following classes: Club class, 15m Mixed class and Open Mixed class.

Club class (on base of handicap index list)

Only gliders included in the current **CZIL** index list may participate in the Club class competition. The Club class competition is open to all gliders with a CZIL index of maximum **108.8** (**Discus 2a/15m**). The minimum index of a glider in the Club class is 95,6 (VSO 10). Water ballast is not allowed. The minimum number of competitors in this class is 10.

Class 15m Mixed (on base of handicap index list)

The 15m Mixed competition is open to all gliders of the **Standard**, **15m**, **20m MultiSeat** classes. **(from 20m MultiSeat category only gliders up to index 117 and lower are allowed)**, included in the current CZIL index list. Water ballast is allowed. The minimum number of competitors in this class is 10.

Open Mixed class (on base of handicap index list)

The Open Mixed class competition is open to all gliders of the **18m, Open**, **20m MultiSeat** classes included in the current CZIL index list. The minimum number of competitors in this class is 10.

If the final number of competitors in the 15m Mixed and Open Mixed classes does not reach the minimum number of 10 in each class, these classes will be merged. Water ballast will be allowed.

2.2 Safety procedures

An anti-collision system compatible with FLARM[©], or at least an OGN Tracker is recommended.

The use of strobe flash lights system is recommended.

It is also recommended to carry an ELT, PLB Spot, EPIRB or other similar satellite tracking rescue devices.

2.3 Competition area

The competition area includes the Czech Republic, Austria and Germany.

The altitude limit of the competition area is FL95. Further details will be published in the official Local procedures and will be specified during the daily briefings. Please make sure that your third-party insurance covers the territory of all above mentioned countries.

2.5 Maximum number of competitors

The maximum capacity of the competition is 80 gliders.

3. Technical requirements

3.1 Air-to-air communication

Pilots are obliged to use only internationally coordinated VHF frequency channels for air-to-air communication during competition flights. The organizer will assign usable frequency channels to the competitors no later than before the announcement of the first competition task.

Use of frequency channels other than those allocated by the Contest Organizer will be penalized at the discretion of the Contest Director or strictly according to FAI Sporting Regulations Part 3- Appendix A Paragraph 8.6.5.a) I) by disqualification from the contest.
